Notice of Public Meeting

The City of Steamboat Springs is in the process of conducting an Airport Master Plan Study for the Steamboat Springs Airport/Bob Adams Field. The previous Airport Master Plan was completed in 1998 and was based on commercial service aircraft. The updated Airport Master Plan will update user information and provide direction for airport development consistent with the airport's role while considering potential environmental and socioeconomic impacts.

This will be the second of four public information meetings to discuss the progress and present information found during the Master Plan. The meeting will include a presentation on the Forecast Chapter and the Facility Requirements Chapter and will include a discussion of the findings. The meeting will also present some basic information on the next step for the Airport Master Plan, the Development Alternatives and then provide interested parties the opportunity to interact with the consultants.
